ACTION #2 -- THIS WEEK!

1) Keep the Pressure On! Contact Legislators via email, letter, postcard or social media

As the July 1 deadline to pass the FY 2016 budget gets nearer, it is increasingly important to continue to reach out to our legislators.

Continue to contact all of the Republican members of the Assembly Budget and Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee. I have listed below the Republicans who serve on that committee. **It does NOT matter if you live in their LD. They serve the entire state on this committee.** Call and let them know that you want a budget for FY 2016 that includes the actuarially required contribution of 5/7 payment which is \$3.2 billion, not the proposed \$1.3 billion which is far shorter than what is required by law.
